Fee Schedule for Wiring Permits

Residential

New Single family (includes temp. service & 4 inspections)	\$175
New Multi-family (includes temp service & 4 inspections) – per unit	\$140
Service Changes/Upgrades – per 100 Amps	\$40
Major Appliances (new or replacement)	\$45
Renovations/Rewiring of existing buildings – per building unit	100
Temporary (Temp.) Service	\$50
Garages/Out-buildings	\$80
Swimming Pools – All	\$75
Smoke Detectors – per building unit	\$50
Re-inspection Fee	\$50
Phone/Cable/Data/Sound/Thermostats/Intercom Wiring – existing buildings	\$45
Fire and or Burglar Alarms	\$75
MINIMUM FEE	\$45

Commercial & Industrial

MINIMUM FEE	\$75
\$1001 to \$10,000 – per \$1000, or fraction thereof	\$20
\$10,001 and over – per \$1000, or fraction thereof	\$15
Service Changes/Upgrades/Repairs – each meter – per Amp	\$0.50 per Amp
Phone/Cable/Data/Sound/Thermostats/Intercom Wiring – existing buildings	\$50 each
Temporary (Temp.) Service	\$50
Signs/Marqueses	\$50
Blanket Maintenance Fees – per year	\$250

Notes:

All payments must be either check or money-order. NO CASH.

Must be made out to the TOWN OF PHILLIPSTON.

All applications must be completely filled out and signed by a Mass. licensed electrician.

(Homeowners can no longer pull electrical permits due to liability issues.)

Permits are required within 5 days of beginning work.

All permits expire one year from date of issue, or if electrical contractor is changed. May be extended with permission of Wiring Inspector.

All permit fees are accumulative and non-refundable.

All mechanical grounds shall be made-up for rough inspection.

A Certificate of Insurance (one per calendar year) is required to grant permit, made out to the 'Town of Phillipston'. Either send in with permit, or fax to 978-249-3356.

Permit fees waived for municipal work valued at less than \$7500.00.

Failure to apply for a permit as per Mass. General Laws – will result in a Double Fee.
